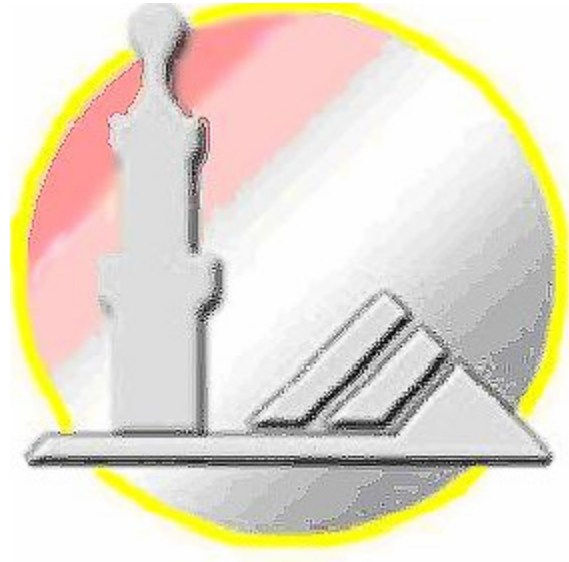

Arrival in Canada

It would be best that you plan to arrive by mid-August to have time to organize your new life in your city: finding a place to live, furnishing your apartment, registering for classes, opening a bank account, etc.

To find out when classes start, please check your admission documents.

WHEN ARRIVING AT THE PORT OF ENTRY IN CANADA,

Make sure you go to the Canada Immigration Office to complete all required procedures. Ask the customs officer to direct you to its location.

Do not leave the Canadian border until all of your documents have been properly processed

Otherwise you will have to return to the Canadian border to obtain your Study Permit.

Arrival by plane Montreal is served by PIERRE- ELLIOTT- TRUDEAU International airport.

The airport is about 19 kilometres (9.8 miles) from Montreal downtown and is served by the L'AÉROBUS SHUTTLE bus service that is relatively inexpensive.

Taxis

Once you arrive in Canada, you will discover that taxis are quite expensive.

A taxi from Pierre Elliott Trudeau Airport to downtown Montreal will cost you approximately \$35.

If you must take a taxi from the airport, ask the price for the trip including the charge for baggage handling and the tip, before you get into the car.

You may be able to find another traveller at the airport who will share the taxi fare with you if you are both going downtown; taxis charge the same amount regardless of the number of passengers.
